Embarking on ECT Induction is an exciting experience. Each training session below focuses on the pedagogical content listed and integrates opportunities for ECTs to reflect on the relevant Teachers' Standards, their specific experiences, and addresses how to improve and evidence practice. All sessions will be delivered by highly experienced teaching professionals. We aim to offer 2 cohorts (**Thursday morning's - AM cohort - 9.30am-12.30pm** OR **afternoon's - PM cohort - 1.30pm-4.30pm**). If there are insufficient numbers for 2 cohorts, sessions will take place on a Thursday afternoon only. **Please note: The final session will be a FULL DAY session** for each cohort. **All sessions will take place at The Teaching Centre, Lee Chapel Primary School, The Knares, Basildon, SS16 5RU.** All sessions below are included in 'OPTION A - ECT Pedagogy, Appropriate Body Services and ECT Full Induction Programme'. AREA 1: Developing Resilience and Self Management - Dealing with Difficult Situations

Date: 28 September 2023

The following will be explored during the session:

- To develop confidence in meeting the challenges of communicating effectively with parents including having difficult conversations
- To develop strategies to deal with work life balance
- Developing team work skills to enable you to make a positive contribution to the life of the school

AREA 2: Planning for Progress and Learning

Date: 19 October 2023

The following are explored over both sessions:

- Planning for learning - how to create a plan, with clear objectives
- Intent - teaching points and outcomes
- Lesson design - what to include and how to choose an appropriate starting point
- Planning sequences of lessons - to consolidate and expand on prior knowledge
- Use of AfL and adaptive teaching approaches to enable 'in the moment' teaching

AREA 6: Understanding Autism

Date: 15 February 2024

The following will be explored during the session:

- Identify the key areas to help pupils on the autism spectrum build positive relationships with staff, peers, families and people in their community.
- Develop an awareness of the sensory and communication differences that pupils may experience.
